VM PRAYER SPOTLIGHT –

Robert & Brenda Skutevik serve the Lord with Village Missions at Mission Creek Church in Mission Creek, MN and they write this spotlight on their ministry ...

Mission Creek is a small community located outside of Duluth, MN, named Fond du Lac; it is about 175 people in size. Our church draws about 115-120 each weekend and is a mixture of folks, due to our demographics of being located close to Duluth, MN. We have great opportunity to draw from this larger population, but also face the challenges of having larger churches offer a broader slate of programs for young families.

PRAYER REQUESTS: 1) We have seen growth, especially in our children's ministries, but that growth brings challenges -- use of space, finding more volunteers, and leadership training/development. 2) Our church has had many, many health concerns from our people, almost a disproportionate amount of illness: cancer, life threatening infections, paralysis, someone due to have brain surgery, our daughter, etc.. These tests have drawn us as a church closer together, but we are also still praying for so many struggling and hurting with these trials. 3) We are shifting some leaders and looking to grow our youth group. 4) The church had a history of disunity and divisiveness, something that tore our church apart about 9 years ago, before we came here. We have been healing and growing very much since then. God has been faithful, but continue to pray for greater unity, genuine Christian love & charity, and for healing. I can see at times a fear that lingers in some people's minds, fear of what if the division rears its ugly head again? Even though there is nothing to warrant that fear.
